N. B.

- It is no longer required that students continue to a higher level in high school in order to receive the credit(s) they earn in middle school.
- American Sign Language may be used to fulfill the state graduation requirement; however, both levels must be taken in order for it to do so. ASL cannot be combined with another language to fulfill the requirement.
